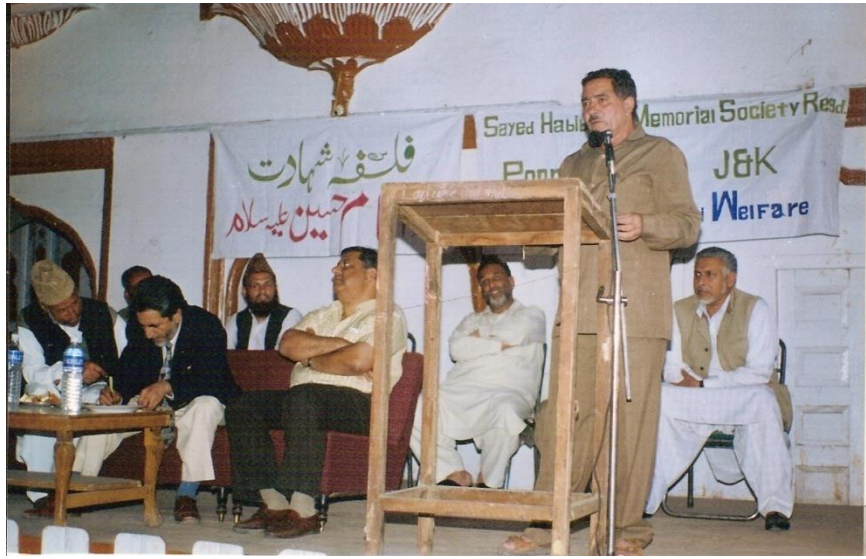

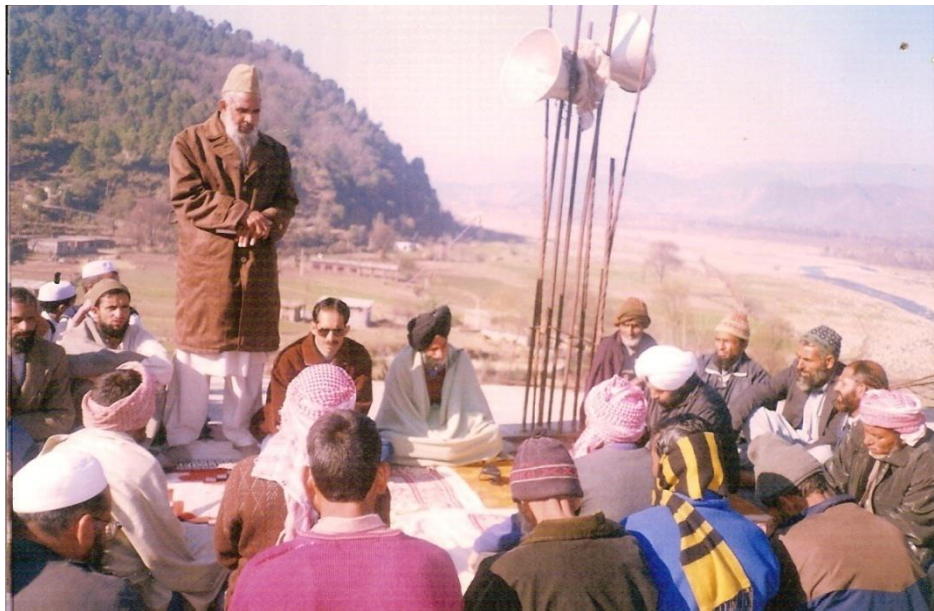
**Activity:- Environmental awareness campaign at**

**Environmental Awareness Programme in Kanuyian Poonch**



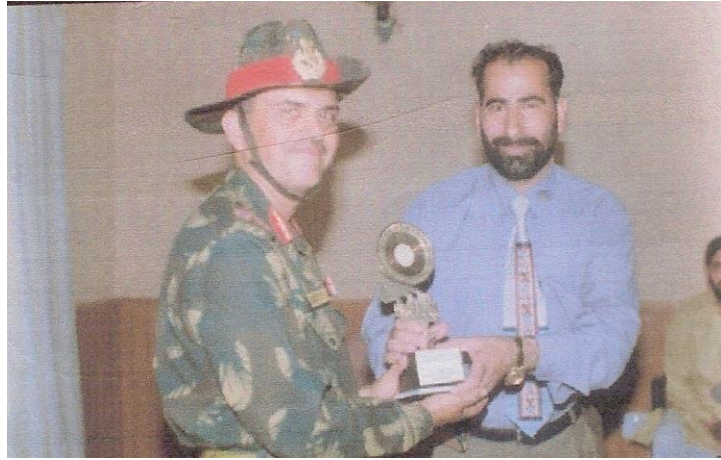
**Activity:- Seminar on civil military liaison to control the menace of terrorism.**

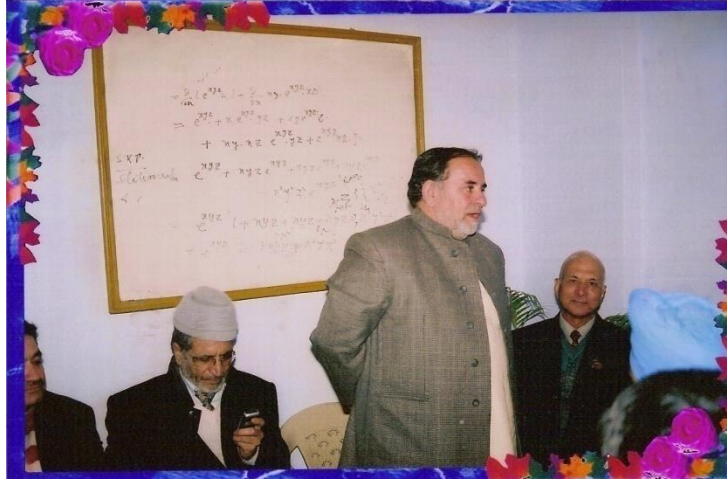
## **Report**

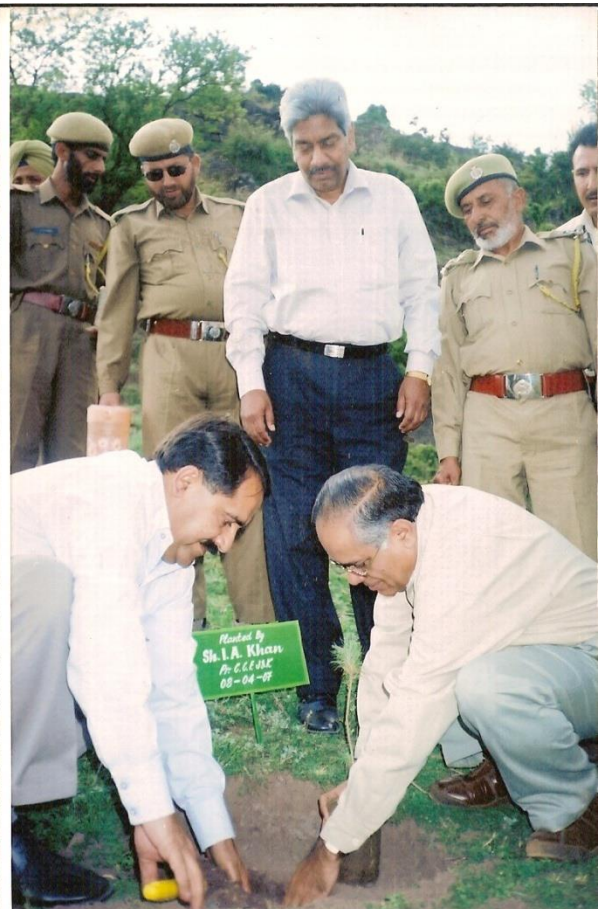

Before this programme Sh. I.A. Khan PCCF, Chief Conservator, Conservator West Circle were taken to Smritivan where they planted saplings.

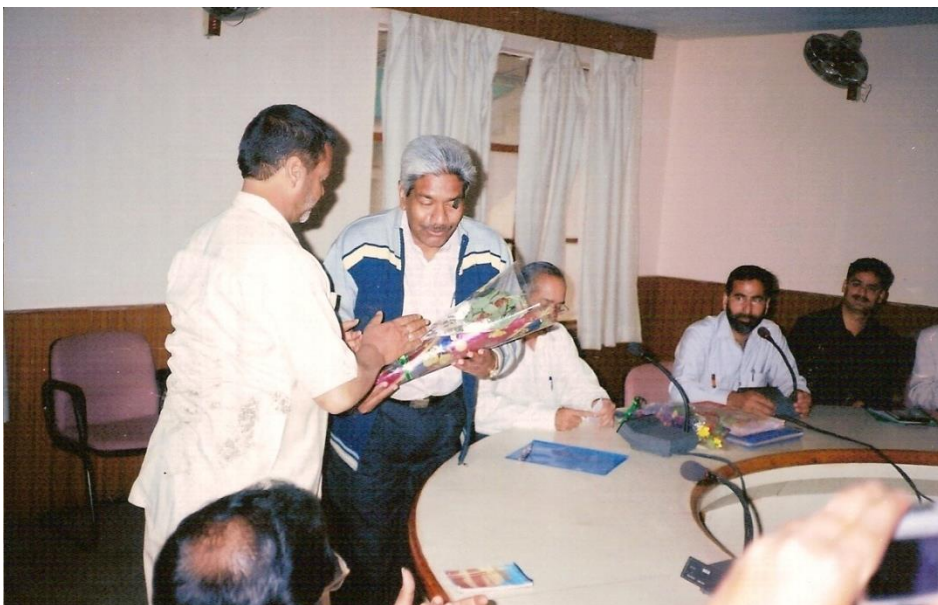

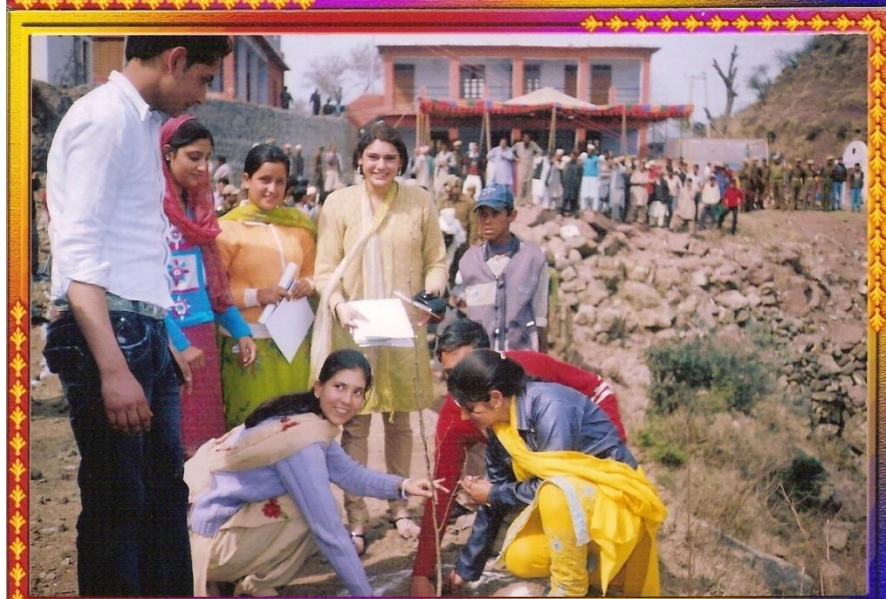
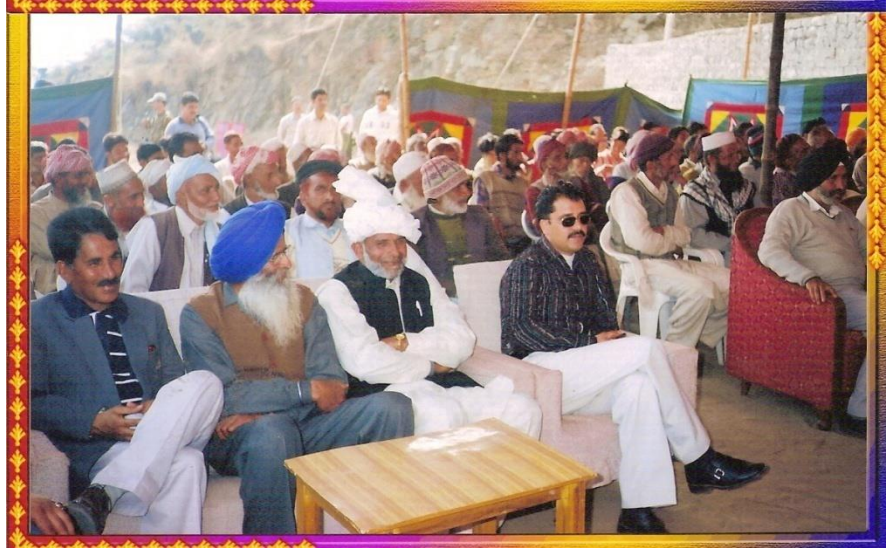
**Report**
